

General Safeguards

- Place your comb binder on a stable surface.
- Use the machine only for its intended purpose of punching and binding paper and document covers according to the indicated specifications.
- Always test the machine with some scrap paper before punching the final document.
- Take care that there are no staples or such like in the documents to be bound.
- · Empty the waste tray regularly.
- · Lift the machine from the bottom, not the cover or the handle.
- Unauthorized maintenance is not allowed.

Note: Please do not insert a binding comb until you finish punching papers and covers of the required booklet.



(Fig. 1)
Punching preparation: Turn
the Wheel to adjust A4/A5
paper



(Fig. 2) Punching preparation: Pull the **Punching margin control** from 2mm to 5mm



(Fig. 3)
Push paper(max. 15 sheets of 80gsm at one time) into the Paper entry



(Fig. 4)
Pull the **Handle** all the way down until it stops to punch completely through



Insert and open a comb. Pull over the **Comb opening lock** to the "OPEN" position




Load punched sheets directly onto the opened comb



(Fig. 7)
When finished, release the Comb opening lock and return the Handle to the original position



(Fig. 8)
Remove the bound booklet and enjoy your finished work



(Fig. 9) Empty the **Waste tray**
